Process

- Identifying subjects table of content
- Identifying metrics for each subject
- Finding and selecting data sources
- Download and select rows/columns
- Additional computations
- Reformatting for publication (tables and charts)
- Creation of maps
- Generating text
 - General
 - Data driven

Reducing collective workload

Centralization

 One organization making profiles or profile elements for many areas

Crowd sourcing

- Sharing knowledge, e.g.
 - What metrics work
 - Where to find the data
 - How to calculate the metrics
- Sharing products
 - Metrics calculations for many areas
 - General pieces of text
